Where does Devon County Council come in?

As far as Port Royal is concerned, the County Council does not have a large role to play apart from being responsible for roads and pavements, including the turning circle on the Esplanade. Any changes to the roads or pavements would have to be done by them but their budget is very limited. It may be possible to help them find money to fund improvements or changes but this needs to be confirmed. For example changing the surface of the turning circle and/or pavements could add character to the Port Royal area.

The turning circle and associated pavements are on land that should be protected by the Ham conveyance (sheet 4).
